Heiser, *Spiritual Warfare* concepts as captured in Joel Richardson's "Gospel of the Skull Crusher", as well as contemporary discussions surrounding artificial intelligence, *Digital Prophet* examines the relationship between ancient patterns of idolatry and emerging digital technologies.

Written for both believers and seekers, the book challenges readers to consider one of the defining spiritual questions of our age:

When machines begin shaping meaning itself, who—or what—will humanity ultimately follow?
